Please note that the times above are a guide only. Please be ready at your mat to commence bowling when the session previous is completed.

All matches will be played over 9 ends except the final which will be played over 11 ends. Each bowler has four woods per end. The first name/number will play with black woods. Matches up to and including the quarter finals will be timed. A whistle will sound after 27 minutes after which a new end may not be started. Two points are awarded for a win and one point for a draw. In the event of a bye, you will be awarded 2 points (i.e. a win) and 7 shots.

Scorecards to be signed by both players after every match and returned to the competition secretary. The group position will be decided by points, shot difference, shots for, result between two players. If that does not separate the two players then most number of ends won in all group games will be the deciding factor.

The seven group winners, runners up and the two best 3rd place finishers will advance through to the last sixteen. We have done this to keep more people involved in the competition for a longer period of time. The last sixteen will be played over two sessions in the main hall, to ensure that we have enough markers for these matches.

Please note that there are only 32 entrants in the competition, of which 16 will be playing in each session. Markers will be required for each game in each session. Which will mean that 7 of the 16 players sitting out will be needed to mark. If you have not done so before it is very straight forward. All you need to do is remove any foul woods (i.e. woods that touch the middle, go of the end) from the carpet. At no point in time should you advise what is holding unless you are specifically asked by either player. You may also be required to measure if the two players cannot decide what is holding, please don't let this put you off. If you are not able or confident in measuring then there will be somebody nearby that can offer assistance.

Please note for those of you that have not played at the school before, as you enter the main bowling hall there is a small step. There is signage on the door warning there is a step and it is also coloured in yellow paint, however when we played our county game two people did trip up this and fall. Therefore, please take care when entering/exiting the hall. There are also doors in the middle of the hall that lead to the dining area. Please do not use these doors to enter/exit the hall as it may disturb the persons bowling.

There will be raffle tickets and refreshments available to purchase throughout the day. The cost to hire the hall is £195. As the entries for the competition are disappointingly low and will only recover £128, we encourage you to purchase food and raffle tickets to help support the funding of the event.

Please arrive at 9am and assist in setting up the hall for the day, also please register with the competition secretary and pay your entry fee of £4 per player if you have not done so already. Finally, thank you for supporting this event and we hope you enjoy the day.
